

Frequently Asked Questions

Deadline: this is NOT a “first come, first serve” show.

Returning vendors will have a deadline date of **June 1, 2026**

New vendors will be considered after that date.

Exhibitor Standards: All work must be hand crafted by the artist or craftsperson, and that person must attend the Poquoson Seafood Festival. (No kits, imports, buy/sell merchandise, t-shirts are accepted. This will be strictly enforced, and you will be asked to leave immediately without a refund.) Food items are no longer accepted in the Arts and Crafts area.

Booth Space: Each space is 10’X10’ in a wooded area. Be prepared for trees, straw etc. 1 parking pass per space.

Electricity: Each space has access to electricity and is included in the booth fee. You will need a 100 ft.-3-pronged extension cord. (No more than 300 watts per space) No generators.

Weather: There is no rain date. The festival will remain open unless the Staff determines the conditions to be unsafe. Please be prepared for all weather conditions. In case of inclement weather, please check *poquosonseafestival.com*

Set-Up: Please comply with the following set-up times.

Thursday October 15, 2026, 9am to 4pm

Friday October 16, 2026, 7am to 4pm

*There is no vehicle access to your space. We recommend a dolly or wagon for unloading/loading.

Security: Security is provided throughout the park from Thursday, October 15 thru Sunday, October 18, 2026

Trash: You are expected to leave your space the way you found it. No large trash, boxes, carpets, large debris should be left. This will be closely monitored.

***A cashed check is your confirmation into the show. There will be a \$40 fee on returned checks.**
